A POINT TO REMEMBER - YOUR SIGNATURE

Any time you are invited to sign anything, make sure you understand the exact details and implications. Sign only when you personally are totally committed to and agree with what you are signing. If you are not, walk away and take time to consider again. Do not sign under any pressure, whether direct or indirect, peers or adults, and don't sign anything as part of a joke.
