Dear Parent/Guardian

Welcome back to 2020. The school hopes Year 12 will be both rewarding and challenging for our students.

For students to be eligible to participate in co-curricular activities and other school functions, including the school Formal, and also to ensure they don't jeopardize their opportunities at Kingaroy State High School the following criteria must be met:

1. A minimum of 90% attendance over the 2 years of 11 & 12 (if there is an extended illness the provision of a **Medical Certificate** is required)
2. Completion of assessment in **ALL** subjects in Unit 3 & 4 to a satisfactory level
3. Completion of vocational courses by Friday 23 October 2020 (end of week 3 Term 4)
4. Complete the 'Career Education Program'
5. Complete the 'BRAKE Program'
6. Complete the 'First Aid Certificate'
7. No N's at exit
8. Be on track to achieve their QCE
9. Demonstrate appropriate behaviour throughout 2020, two or more suspensions will exclude students from the Formal

To attend the Formal on Friday 18 September 2020, students will need to meet the above criteria and also pay all outstanding fees (please contact Mrs Gabby Flanigan [gflan8@eq.edu.au](mailto:gflan8@eq.edu.au) at the office if you wish to set up a payment plan).

The invitation for any student to attend the Formal will be at the Principal's discretion.

The students eligible to attend the Formal, including the red carpet, are those from Year 12 who attend Kingaroy State High School. Younger students, siblings, or other community members, who do not attend Kingaroy State High School, are not eligible to attend, or accompany students on the red carpet.

The Guidance Officer is able to discuss your options, pathways and/or other areas of concern that may be impacting on your ability to achieve to your full potential.
